

## **Sport at Stanwell**

Stanwell has very good facilities centred upon an impressive Sports Hall and Fitness Suite. This is well equipped for a wide variety of sports including basketball and cricket. Outdoors, there are six hard standing tennis/netball courts and extensive grassed areas with both rugby and football pitches.

The school aims to offer pupils experience of a wide range of different sports during their five years of compulsory education. The curriculum aims to develop the potential of each pupil and offers the opportunity to experience the enjoyment of sporting activity at all levels.

There are many pupils who represent the County in sports such as athletics, cricket, rugby and hockey. Stanwell pupils take part in a wide range of competitions at County and National level with details of individual and school achievements printed in the newsletter for parents and published on the school website ([www.stanwell.org](http://www.stanwell.org))

There are many school teams in sports such as rugby, football, hockey, cross country, basketball, tennis and athletics that take part in fixtures after school and at weekends. Sport is an important aspect of Stanwell's many extracurricular activities.

## **Cymraeg – Welsh**

Welsh is taught as a second language to all pupils in KS3 and KS4, leading to a GCSE full course qualification.

The department is staffed by well qualified fluent Welsh speakers who strive to develop the pupils' awareness of Welsh and its relevance to life in Wales today.

## **Work Experience**

All Year 10 pupils undertake a Work Placement at the end of the academic year.
