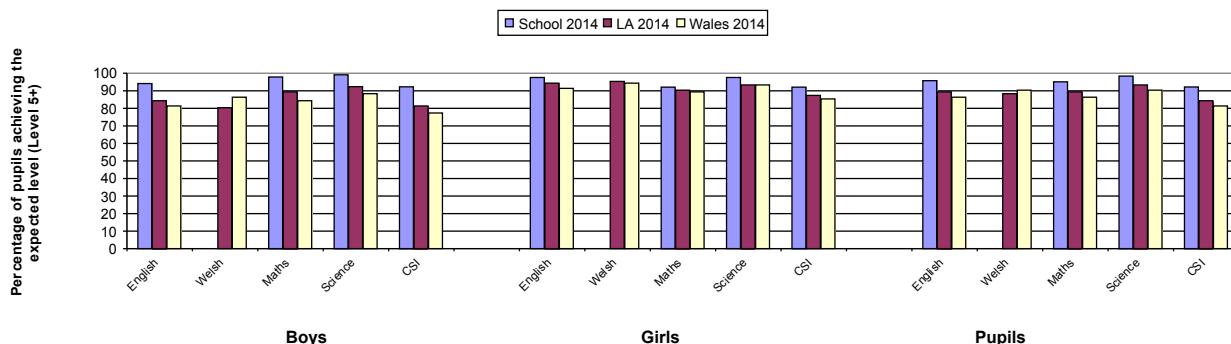


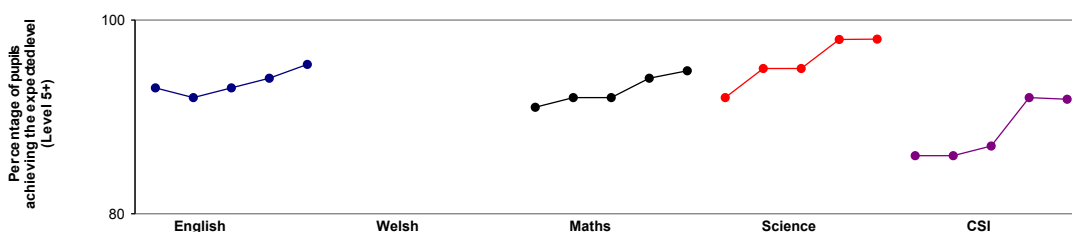

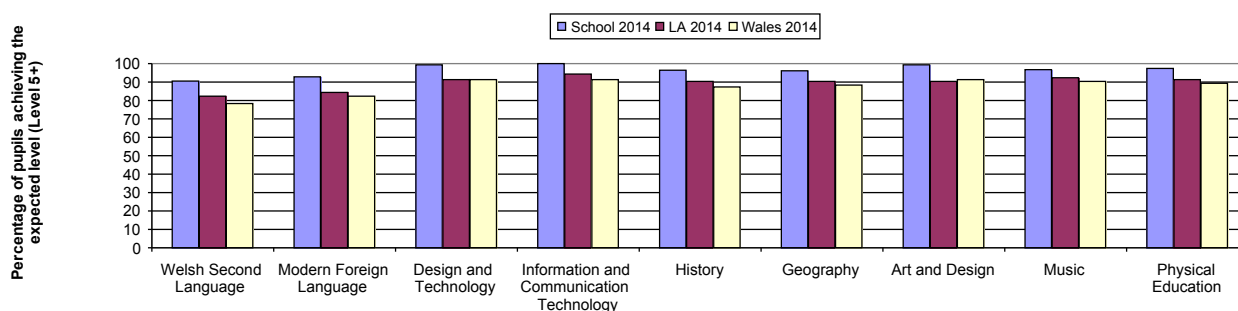
**Notes:**

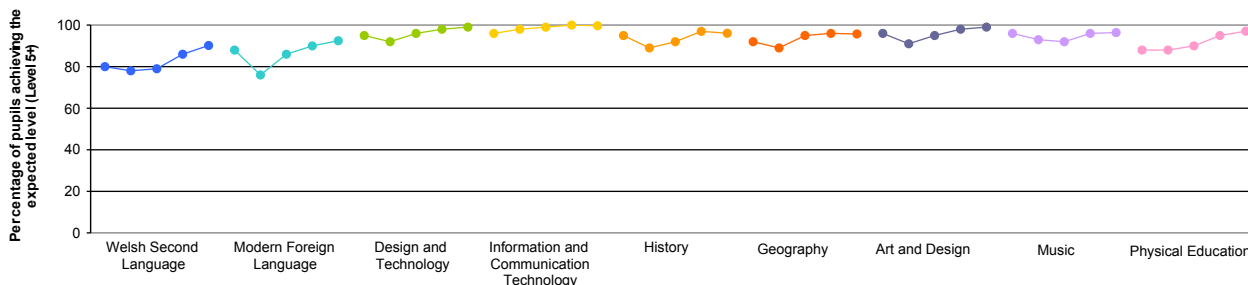
