Dear Parents/Carers,

As the school year draws to a close in exceptionally warm weather, I would like to remind you of our uniform expectations for September. Full school uniform will resume from the first day for pupils, Tuesday 4th September 2018.

As a school we have always been proud of the standards we set for school uniform and general appearance. Your child will be fully aware of these rules and I ask for your co-operation in ensuring the points below are adhered to:

- Blazers with the school badge are compulsory for sixth form students.
- Ties – All sixth formers wear the sixth form tie, blue with the school badge for Y12 (purchased only from school) and gold with navy stripes for Y13 (presented to students in September), or a Stanwell Sports Colours Tie.
- Jewellery – Only one simple stud earring in the lobe of each ear. No facial piercings or visible tattoos. Watches are permitted.
- Jumpers/Cardigans – Optional plain knitted black or navy v-necked pullover with school badge.
- Skirts - Navy pin stripe skirt of approved length (knee length) or pleated skirt with the school badge.
- Plain navy or plain black coats.
- Plain leather black flat shoes, no trainers, canvas, velcro straps.
- No unusual hairstyles, shaved heads, tramlines, braids or dyed hair.
- Beards and facial hair should be neatly trimmed.
