



Dear Parents/Carers of Year 11 students,

We have been contacted by the WJEC and asked to inform you that, for the awarding of qualifications this summer, Non Examination Assessment (coursework) will not be moderated. This means that coursework marks will not be uploaded to the WJEC, sampled and moderated as usually happens. If your child has already submitted all coursework then there is no need to do anything further. Coursework submission deadlines in many subjects have not yet been reached, so if your child has not yet submitted their coursework, there is no requirement to do so from now on. If your child wishes to carry on with coursework tasks to occupy their time during this uncertain period they are most welcome to do so and to submit work to their subject teachers, however, they do not have to do this. This also applies to the Welsh Baccalaureate Skills Challenge certificate components.

We are still awaiting precise information from the WJEC about how examination grades will be awarded. Clearly, modules already sat will play a part, as will any marks already submitted to the exam board. Teachers will also be asked to give predicted grades based on all the work students have done so far. Heads of Department will be in contact with students directly if there are any differences to this in individual subjects.

As always, when we are given further information by the WJEC, we will share this with you.
