Re: **Parent/carer consent- Enrichment Week Visits 28th June-2nd July 2021**

Following the challenging year we have been through and the extended periods of school closure experienced by our pupils, we have decided to facilitate an Enrichment Week for all pupils in Years 7,8,9,10 and 12 during the Summer term. This week will involve pupils undertaking a series of fun and enriching activities which will promote a healthy sense of wellbeing and aid social interaction. Although presently, this is in its early stages of planning, we envisage that pupils will be involved in selecting some of the activities on offer that are of particular interest to them. Some of these activities may take place off school site, within the local area and within walking distance from the school. All other activities will be facilitated in school. Pupils will be provided with more details on our Enrichment Week during their pastoral sessions later this week.


I hereby agree to my child participating in enrichment visits off the school/establishment site.

- such visits will normally take place within the school/establishment normal hours, but that if, occasionally, they are likely to extend beyond this, adequate advance notice will be given so that I may make appropriate arrangements for my child's return home;
- all reasonable care will be taken of my child during the visit;
- my child will be under an obligation to obey all directions given and to observe all rules and regulations governing the visit and will be subject to all normal school/establishment discipline procedures during the visit;
- I must inform the school/establishment of any medical condition that may affect them during the visit;
- I understand that it is my responsibility to update the school if any circumstances change.
- I understand that the school may need to adapt or cancel any scheduled visits in light of Covid19 guidance changes or inclement weather.
