

The day is designed to familiarise new pupils with the routine and expectations of the school and to get a taste of Stanwell School life. After a rather challenging year, we are very hopeful that we will be able to welcome Year 6 pupils onto our school site for this transition visit in June and have therefore made plans to accommodate this. It must be noted however, that we are still awaiting final confirmation as to whether this will be possible as if the situation with regards to Covid 19 changes and further restrictions are put in place, it may be necessary to review these arrangements. If there are any changes to the plans outlined in this letter, we will communicate them with your child's primary school who will inform you directly.

We have liaised closely with your child's primary school and will maintain appropriate Covid restrictions whilst your child is on Stanwell School site. During the transition visit, your child will attend some taster lessons within their primary school/class bubble and will also be expected to wear a face covering for their visit. Face coverings will need to be worn in all taster lessons and in communal areas of the school but can be removed when consuming food or drink. We will be able to supply face coverings to Year 6 pupils who are unable to provide their own. If you wish your child to be exempt from wearing a face covering, please inform your child's primary school and provide an exemption note for your child to bring with them on the day of their visit to Stanwell.

Your child's primary school are aware of the arrangements for this transition visit and will communicate arrangements for travelling to and from Stanwell school site directly with you. Pupils should arrive at Stanwell School by 9.15 a.m. at the Salisbury Avenue entrance. Refreshments will be provided free of charge in the morning but a set lunch can be purchased from ourselves at a cost of £2.00, this must be paid in cash on the day of the visit. Alternatively, you may wish to provide your child with their own packed lunch. It is advisable for pupils to bring a water bottle with them for their visit. Pupils will be ready to leave at 2.00 p.m and again, your child's primary school will communicate travel arrangements with you directly.

If you wish your child to take part in this visit, please complete the slip below and return it to your child's Year 6 teacher who will pass all replies onto me prior to the visit.

In past years we have held a New Parents' evening at Stanwell School during the Summer term. Unfortunately due to Covid restrictions, it will not be possible to hold this event in person this year, but please rest assured that we will be sending a pre-recorded information video to all parents/carers early next term. We will also be providing both yourselves and your children with extensive written and audio visual information about arrangements for starting at Stanwell and indeed all aspects of Stanwell school life along with information about who to contact with any questions you may have prior to starting at Stanwell School. All this information will also be sent out at the start of the Summer term and will be uploaded to our school website and shared with primary schools.

We are really looking forward to meeting all our future Year 7 pupils in person and feel confident that as the summer term progresses both you and your child will feel fully informed and confident about starting at Stanwell in September. In the meantime, should you have any questions or if there are any matters you would like to discuss please contact the school to make an appointment at a mutually convenient time.
